BOTSWANA

Our Botswana-based operator offers some of the finest plains game hunting available anywhere in Africa. Their expansive private concession provides outstanding hunting opportunities for Eland, Kudu, Oryx, and more. Their 7-day plains game package is exceptionally affordable and offers unbeatable value, including six trophy animals. Over the years, numerous clients have hunted there and consistently praised their operation.

For dangerous game, the same operator manages some of the premier big game government concessions in Botswana. These concessions allow for hunting Elephant, buffalo, and leopard. The leopard hunts, conducted with Bushman trackers, offer a thrilling experience.

CAMEROON

Cameroon presents two unique hunting experiences. In the Northern Savannah, key species include the Lord Derby Eland, Savannah buffalo, Western Roan, and Hippo. You can also hunt various sub-species of plains game unique to West Africa. If you haven't hunted in West Africa, you haven't hunted these species. Go while the opportunity exists. Savannah hunts occur from January to May.

The forest hunt in Southern Cameroon features main species such as the Bongo, dwarf forest buffalo, forest Sitatunga and elephant, along with a variety of forest duikers, including the rare yellow-backed duiker. This is an incredible hunting experience with pygmy trackers and their dogs. The season runs from March to early June.

MOZAMBIQUE

Our partner in Mozambique operates across several different concessions, offering all the various species that one can hunt in Mozambique. This destination is exceptional for hunting lion, leopard, buffalo, Roosevelt sable, bushpig, other species of plains game, along with hippo and huge crocodiles. The Niassa region, offers outstanding hunts for lion, leopard, buffalo, and plains game unique to the area. This remote location is ideal for tracking old dugga boys. In the south, Cahora Bassa offers some of the best hunting in Africa for large crocodiles, which are often man-eaters and represent one of Africa's greatest trophies. Both Lion and Leopard hunts have a high success rate.

NAMIBIA

Namibia is one of Africa's premier destinations for plains game hunts. Our partners manage large private game farms teeming with diverse game species. Their lodges are very comfortable, featuring beautifully appointed chalets with all modern amenities, ensuring a pleasant stay for both hunters and non-hunting companions. Our partners can also organize sightseeing tours before or after your hunting safari. In addition to plains game, both black and white rhinos can be hunted in Namibia. Leopard hunting here is excellent, with quality as high as the best found anywhere in Africa. These hunts are also reasonably priced when compared to other African countries.

In northern Namibia, near Khaudum National Park, we offer some of the finest elephant hunts available in Africa. We average ivory in the low 70s each year in this area. With a small annual quota, hunts get booked quickly, so if a large elephant is in your future, please contact us in advance. The wilderness camp, with thatched and canvas accommodations, is set in a beautiful sand forest area and includes all amenities, including Wi-Fi.

SOUTH AFRICA

We work with several top outfitters in South Africa. Our outfitter in Kwazulu Natal offers several different species on his own private property. He also has access to 1000's of acres of cattle farms and free-range hunting areas in close vicinity. He has a unique hunt for Kudu in the months of January and February when the Kudu leave the thick cover and bush to come out into the open areas to escape the mopane flies. This is an incredible hunt where you will see countless bulls. The hunt is done by glassing and then planning a stalk much like a hunt for Mountain Nyala. This area is also excellent for Nyala, Common and mountain reedbuck as well as a good selection of plains game. His hunts are also excellent value for money. Being a small operator, you will receive a personalized service and be welcomed warmly.

TANZANIA

Tanzania is one of Africa's premier safari destinations, offering an incredible diversity of species. Partnering with one of the top outfitters, we provide hunts in Masailand, Central, and Western Tanzania. The hunt in Masailand includes all the unique plains game species of the region, such as the desirable Lesser Kudu, Gerenuk, and various gazelles. ARGENTINA

Partnering with a small outfitter who provides personalized service, we offer all the big-game and bird species available in Argentina. Argentina is a bird shooter's paradise, offering unmatched volume dove and pigeon shooting. With liberal limits and an abundance of ducks, you'll feel like you're in duck heaven. Let us tailor a fantastic hunting experience for you in Argentina.

AUSTRALIA

Our partner in Arnhem Land offers over a million acres of exclusive hunting territory teeming with free-ranging buffalo. Their remote tented camp in Arnhem Land provides an excellent base for hunting both trophy and cull buffalo. Additional species such as donkeys, pigs, camels and scrub bulls (feral cattle) can also be hunted. This is a highly enjoyable hunt, perfect for big bore or double rifle enthusiasts, as it offers plenty of shooting opportunities. There are also options for large cull hunts.

Banteng are hunted in Coburg National Park. Banteng are wild bovines introduced from Southeast Asia, now endangered in their native countries they can only be hunted in Australia. In addition to Banteng, there is great fishing to enjoy on this hunt as it is on the coast.

BULGARIA

Bulgaria is a premier Eastern European hunting destination, renowned for its exceptional free-range native red stag. A red stag hunt during the roar will be one of your greatest hunting experiences. It's one of the few countries outside Russia where you can hunt Capercaillie. The Balkan chamois are also unique to Bulgaria, along with most other native European species such as roe deer, wildboar, mouflon and fallow deer. We offer affordable cull hunts for red deer and fallow hinds in October. Accommodation is in small country hotels or comfortable lodges with all modern amenities, either in the hunting area or a short distance away. Experienced guides tailor the hunt to suit hunters of all ages and physical abilities.

GREENLAND

Greenland offers one of the most unforgettable and unique hunting adventures. Apart from a great hunt, you will witness the polar ice cap, the northern lights, and experience true Arctic life. The main species are Musk Ox and Caribou. For those interested solely in Musk Ox, our Spring hunts in March are ideal. Suitable for hunters of all ages and physical abilities, these hunts utilize ATVs, making them relatively easy compared to the more challenging Musk Ox hunts in Canada. A comfortable, warm cabin and home-cooked meals ensure a pleasant experience.

KYRGYZSTAN

The Republic of Kyrgyzstan is renowned for its hunts for Marco Polo sheep and mid-Asian ibex. The Marco Polo sheep here, often referred to as the Tian Shan Marco Polo, generally have shorter horns compared to those in Tajikistan, but they boast considerable mass, similar to big horn sheep. These hunts are more affordable than those in Tajikistan and offer mountain hunters a delightful experience, with horse riding and camping in the picturesque high country. The mid-Asian ibex here have a distinctive white saddle and typically measure between 40 to 50 inches. Our partner, who has been conducting these hunts for several years, operates a very reliable and well-regarded outfit.

NEW ZEALAND

Located on the South Island, just a few hours' drive from Queenstown, our New Zealand partner offers exceptional hunts for Red Stag, Elk, and most other species found in the region. Our Tajik operator offers hunts for Bukhara and Pamir Ibex, Markhor, and Marco Polo sheep. Hunters can typically expect sheep in the mid to high fifty inch range. Combination hunts for Marco Polo and Ibex are also available. These are challenging mountain hunts, so prepare accordingly and experience the hunt of a lifetime.

TURKEY

Turkey offers some of the best wild boar hunting opportunities today. The local hunters generally do not hunt wild boar, resulting in an abundance of these animals. Wild boar hunting can be done by stalking in the moonlight at bait sites as well as driven hunts. Yacht-based boar hunts are also available. Additionally, our outfitter partner has access to some of the best areas for Bezoar Ibex. The hunting concession of 75,000 hectares is located in North Western Cameroon, bordering Faro National Park. The hunting concession is landlocked between a 1300 high mountain chain and the magnificent Faro river and one of its tributaries, Mayo Ndugba, which serves as a natural barrier against poachers during the rainy season. The concession has 250 km of dirt roads without villages or local inhabitants and is a 4 hour drive (175 Kms) from Ngaoundere in the South.

Embracing the style of local architecture, the camp is situated on the banks of the Faro River. This idyllic setting provides clients with a relaxing atmosphere and camp. Locally sourced foods and a mix of local and French cuisine are enjoyed by our guests. A full bar is also provided. Clients thatched roof bungalows are furnished with king size beds with mosquito nets with en-suite bathrooms. Daily laundry service is included. Camp is solar powered. Wi-Fi access is included.
